
The event was successful in helping students understand the global opportunities available to them, while also motivating them to plan their future careers thoughtfully and strategically.

The final session discussed the ethical and emotional challenges that forensic nurses often encounter, including dealing with victims of trauma and navigating complex legal systems. The session emphasized the importance of self-care, continued education, and emotional support in handling such sensitive cases.

### Introduction

The online national-level e-conference on *Advancement in Digital Health Care* was organized by the Faculty of Nursing at Parul University, Vadodara, Gujarat. ### Introduction

The Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) program on CPR and BLS Skilled Training (Child) was successfully organized by the Medical-Surgical Nursing Department of Sakhar Kamgar Hospital Trust Seva Nursing School and College on 18th and 19th October 2024. The program aimed to provide participants with essential skills and knowledge in performing Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Basic Life Support (BLS) specifically for children.

This two-day CNE was designed for nursing students and faculty to enhance their proficiency in handling pediatric emergencies. The participants received a comprehensive understanding of child-specific life-saving techniques, empowering them to act confidently and competently in emergency situations.

### Objectives of the CNE

The main objectives of the CNE were:

- To enhance the skills and confidence of nursing students in responding to pediatric emergencies.
- To ensure that nursing professionals are proficient in performing life-saving interventions for children in critical conditions.

### **Program Overview**

### Day 1 (18th October 2024)

Morning Session (9:00 AM - 1:00 PM):

The CNE began with an introduction to pediatric emergency care, focusing on CPR and BLS for children. Mr. Vaibhav Bhosale, the subject expert from Women's and Child Hospital, Dhule, led the first session. Key topics discussed included:

- Understanding the basic principles of CPR and BLS for children
- o Recognizing signs of cardiac arrest in infants and children
- o Proper techniques for one-rescuer and two-rescuer CPR
- The steps involved in airway management for children

Afternoon Session (2:00 PM - 5:00 PM):

Following the lunch break, participants engaged in hands-on training. Mr. Bhosale demonstrated essential pediatric life-saving techniques, and students practiced CPR and BLS on child mannequins. The session also included:

o Performing chest compressions and rescue breathing for children

o Using Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in pediatric emergencies

o Practicing teamwork and communication in pediatric emergency care

### Day 2 (19th October 2024)

• Morning Session (9:00 AM - 1:00 PM):

On the second day, Dr. Rahul Deshmukh from MGM Medical College and Hospital, N-6 CIDCO, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, took over the expert session. Dr. Deshmukh provided a deeper understanding of more advanced pediatric emergency procedures. Topics covered included:

Advanced airway management techniques in children

Pediatric trauma management and recognizing shock

 Treatment of common pediatric emergencies like choking, asthma, and seizures

 Pediatric life support techniques, including medication administration in emergencies

Afternoon Session (2:00 PM - 5:00 PM):

The final session of the CNE involved practical, simulation-based training. Students participated in different skill stations where they performed CPR and BLS techniques on child mannequins. Dr. Deshmukh and the organizing team provided feedback and guidance during the practice sessions to ensure proper technique and effective responses to pediatric emergencies.

### **Outcome and Impact**

The CNE successfully met its objectives, with participants gaining critical skills and knowledge necessary to manage pediatric emergencies effectively. The combination of theoretical learning and practical training provided a well-rounded education on CPR and BLS for children.

By the end of the program, participants demonstrated increased confidence in their ability to perform life-saving procedures in pediatric emergencies. The hands-on training allowed them to refine their techniques and feel more prepared to respond appropriately in real-life situations.

The event received positive feedback from all participants, who appreciated the expert instruction and the opportunity to practice life-saving techniques. The CNE not only strengthened the participants' technical abilities but also reinforced the importance of being well-prepared to handle critical situations in pediatric care.





- Overview:



#### Introduction

The CNE on *Advanced Emergency Procedures* was organized by the Medical-Surgical Nursing Department of Sakhar Kamgar Hospital Trust Seva Nursing School and College on 20th and 21st January 2025. #### Introduction

A Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) workshop on Basics of Pharmacology was successfully conducted for the third and fourth-semester B.Sc. Nursing students at Seva Nursing College, Shrirampur. 

## **Community Spirit:**



#### Conclusion:


The Women Empowerment session at Seva Nursing College was a resounding success. It provided students and staff with essential knowledge on legal rights, safety, and empowerment.


The presence of these dignitaries further encouraged the students and staff, making the celebration more memorable.

## **Community Spirit:**




## Role of College Leadership:

The Women Empowerment session at Seva Nursing College was a resounding success. It provided students and staff with essential knowledge on legal rights, safety, and empowerment.






