LIBRARY ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

Program featured a lecture-cum-demonstration introducing students to the library's resources, services, rules, and staff, evaluation of web resources, and the ethical use of information. A live demonstration was also conducted on how to use the library catalogue and databases in house and also remotely. An interactive Q&A session provided students with an opportunity to clarify their doubts regarding the effective use of library services. Dedicated sessions are also organized to provide hands-on training on accessing e-resources, searching the catalogue, and navigating the library's website and databases.




The services and operations in the central library are fully computerized.

Report on Savitribai Phule Jayanti

Savitribai Phule Jayanti is celebrated every year on 3rd January to honor the birth anniversary of Savitribai Phule, in SKH trusts Seva Nursing College. Savitribai Phule was India's first female teacher and a great social reformer. 3rd January 2026 is observed to remember her remarkable contribution to women's education and social equality in India. On this occasion, a garlanding or portrait was done by Patharkar kanchan 10am at SKH trusts Seva Nursing College. The program began with the lighting of the lamp and floral tributes offered to the portrait of Savitribai Phule. Students and teachers actively participated in the event with great respect and enthusiasm.

Report of anniversary



Objectives of the Programme


- To pay tribute to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar on his birth anniversary.

Report on Birth Anniversary of Florence Nightingale



Activities Conducted


